KINDNESS

EPHESIANS 4:30

30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.

EPHESIANS 4:31

31 Let all *BITTERNESS, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice:

BITTERNESS: GREEK LEXICON -- STRONG'S NUMBER 4088 pikria {pik-ree'-ah} bitter gall, a bitter root, and so producing a bitter fruit.

Mererrah, denoting "that which is bitter" hence the term is applied to the

"bile" or "gall" (the fluid secreted by the liver), It is also used of the "poison"

of serpents, Job 20:14, which the ancients erroneously believed was their gall.

Believers are to get rid of the <u>FIVE VICES OF BITTERNESS</u>,

WRATH (thymos, "outbursts of anger"),

ANGER (orge), "settled feeling of anger"), brawling

CLAMOUR (krauge) "shouting or crying",

EVIL SPEAKING,

blasphemia {blas-fay-me'-ah} blasphemy, railing, slander, injurious speech injurious, to another's good name

MALICE: GREEK LEXICON -- STRONG'S NUMBER 2549 kakia {kak-ee'-ah} ill-will, desire to injure, evil, naughtiness) malignity,

Bitterness leads to wrath, which is the explosion on the outside of the feelings on the inside.

Wrath and anger often lead to brawling (clamor) or blasphemy (evil speaking).

EPHESIANS 4:32

32 And be ye *KIND one to another, tenderhearted, FORGIVING ONE ANOTHER, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.

KIND: GREEK LEXICON -- STRONG'S NUMBER 5543 chrestos {khrase-tos'}

Gracious, virtuous, good, mild, pleasant (as opp. to harsh, hard sharp, bitter) of things: more pleasant, benevolent

Christianity produces true courteousness, or politeness.

It does not make one rough, crabbed, sour;

I CORINTHIANS 13:4

4 ¶ Charity suffereth long, and is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up,

EPHESIANS 4:32

32 And be ye kind one to another, **TENDERHEARTED**, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.

<u>TENDERHEARTED.</u> Having a heart disposed to pity and compassion, and especially

disposed to show kindness to the faults of erring brethren,

The watchword for Christians, and for all people, is "FORGIVE OR FORFEIT FORGIVENESS!"

EPHESIANS 4:32

32 And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.

GOD FOR CHRIST'S SAKE - Greek, 'God in Christ' (2 Cor 5:19). It is in giving Christ as

a propitiation for our sins that God offers forgiveness to us.

It cost God the death of His Son, as man, to forgive us.

It costs us nothing to forgive our fellow-man.

The way we can be enabled to forgive is through the forgiveness which we

ourselves already have received for Christ's sake. As God's love produces our

IUVC,

SO OUR REALIZATION OF GOD'S FORGIVENESS PRODUCES

OUR FORGIVENESS OF OTHERS.

MATTHEW 6:14

14 For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you:

MATTHEW 6:15

15 But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

IF YOU HAVE BEEN HOLDING A GRUDGE AND AN UNFORGIVING ATTITUDE FOR 5

Humility is not thinking poorly of oneself. Rather, it is having the proper estimate of

oneself in the will of God (Rom 12:3). The person with humbleness of mind

thinks of others first and not of himself.

MEEKNESS:

Meekness is not weakness; it is power under control.

This word was used to describe a soothing wind, a healing medicine,

and a colt that had been broken.

In each instance, there is power: a wind can become a storm;

too much medicine can kill; a horse can break loose.

But this power is under control.

LONG-SUFFERING

This word is literally "long-temper." The short-tempered person speaks and acts

impulsively and lacks self-control. When a person is longsuffering, he can put up

with provoking people or circumstances without retaliating.

When love rules in our lives, it unites all these spiritual virtues so that there is

harmony, indicating spiritual maturity. This harmony and maturity keep the life

balanced and growing.

COLOSSIANS 3:13

13 *FORBEARING* one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: EVEN AS CHRIST FORGAVE YOU, SO ALSO DO YE.

FORBEARING: To forbear is not only freely to forgive, but to meet half way, with extended hand

GOD'S FORGIVENESS IS COMPLETE AND FINAL; IT IS NOT CONDITIONAL OR PARTIAL.

God has forgiven us "for Christ's sake" (Eph 4:32), and not for our own sake.

COLOSSIANS 3:14

14 And above all these things put on charity, which is the bond of perfectness.

BOND OF PERFECTNESS an upper garment which completes and keeps together the rest,

which, without it, would be loose and disconnected.

I JOHN 4:12

12 No man hath seen God at any time. If we love one another, God dwelleth in us, and his love is perfected in us.

AND HIS LOVE IS PERFECTED IN US.

Is carried out to completion. That is, our love for each other is the REFLECTION of

HIS love reigning in our hearts.

God is love; and it must have been from Him dwelling in us that we drew the real

love we bear to the brethren.

COLOSSIANS 3:15

15 And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful.

Instead of **BITTERNESS**, there ought to be **KINDNESS**;

Instead of wrath, anger, clamor,

and evil-speaking, there ought to be <u>TENDER-HEARTEDNESS</u>;

instead of MALICE, a loving and hearty forgiveness.

I PETER 3:8

8 ¶ Finally, be ye all of one mind, having *COMPASSION one of another, love as brethren, be *PITIFUL, be *COURTEOUS:

COMPASSION: GREEK LEXICON -- STRONG'S NUMBER 4835 sumpathes {soom-path-ace'} suffering or feeling the like with another, sympathetic

PITIFUL: GREEK LEXICON -- STRONG'S NUMBER 2155 eusplagchnos {yoo'-splangkh-nos} tenderhearted, compassionate,

I want to give a warning right here. It says concerning the last days that because of abounding iniquity **the love of many will wax cold.** In the Laodicean, or last age, **SELF LOVE**, **and love**

So many are getting so hard because they haven't realized the effect of this last day spirit. It is time to draw nigh to God and let him fill our lives with His love, or we will feel the coldness of the last day church, and reject the truth of God which alone is able to help us.

THEY SHALL REAP THE WHIRLWIND;

a violent, tearing, and dissipating tempest, which beareth down and destroys all that
